

RED LEVEL – ALL SITES

As per Diocesan Policy

Entry

- Vaccine pass must be presented at entry – paper or phone. (until 11:59pm April 4)
 - We reserve the right to scan and ask for identification of any person whom we do not know
- Mask must be worn on entry
 - to remain on for the entire service during RED level except those who hold a valid pass exemption
- It is expected any directions given by Wardens or Vicar will be followed (or nominated persons)
- Please be patient as we work our way through entering the church

In Church

- Maximum gathered - 200 people (depends on venue space – St Margaret's will be much less, as will Selwyn Chapel)
- 1m distancing will be enforced – seating every second pew.
- Service will be live on Zoom for those who wish to participate from home – e.g. those with illness or uncomfortable attending.
 - Link will be provided on newsletter or can be found on the website homepage
- Taking communion – please come forward at the instruction of the Warden(s) to receive.
 - A wafer will be placed in your hand
 - step away before removing your mask and consume the wafer. Replace mask immediately
 - Return to seat via the outside aisles on the side you sat
- IF YOU WISH TO USE A CUSHION, PLEASE BYO AND TAKE AWAY WITH YOU

- Will not be self-serve. Food and drink to be distributed by the duty team only.
